In November 2021 a frightening sea erosion known as "Tidal Waves," struck, besieged and buried a fishing community under the sea. These are not the massive waves you see in movies. They are much smaller but just as devastating over time. The erosion left hundreds of people homeless including children. There is devastation everywhere you look. The ferocity of the sea erosion caught the people of Fuveme by surprise.

Fuveme lies along the coast of Ghana. This once thriving fishing community attracted tourism and boasted of coconut trees, sharks, sea gulls, dolphins, sea turtles and much more. Today it is completely buried under the water.





Yes, today the sea erosion has left hundreds of school children without homes, without schools, without hope. Above and below you see a handful of the children grouped into a temporary makeshift classroom.

School office and teachers' lounge

The Fuveme Basic School (Kindergarten to Junior High) now shares only four temporary structures which are being used as classrooms for teaching and learning. Properties such as desks, textbooks and other office materials of the school have been destroyed.

The plight of Fuveme residents and their children touched the heart of Hearts for Ghana Mission.



HFGM team paid a courtesy call on the people of Fuveme to assess the extent of damage. This exercise was carried out in collaboration with the chief, Presiding Assembly Man and a representative from the Department of Social Welfare and Community Development.

HFGM team donated some relief items which included: school supplies such as, bags, shoes, stationeries, new and used clothing, rice and CASH.





Practical ministry to needs, coupled with words of encouragement from the HFGM team were delivered to lift their spirits and give them hope for the future.
