Friends, God by His mercy opened the doors for the Mission to acquire the rights to 7.5 acres of land. Because of our ministry to children in the region, the Chief of a nearby village offered to give us the rights to this land at the greatly reduced price of \$30,000 USD.

In 2022, I brought this opportunity to the board and some of our donors. It was greeted enthusiastically.

Last year, \$8,000 was given for the project. The Chief has declared we can pay the balance in installments over the next several years.

In the past, we have always depended on cramped rented quarters for our children. We now have the opportunity to build long term home to house the children and our mission.


What might a permanent home look like?
